LEGAL FRAMEWORK


- Law on Disaster Protection;
- Law on The Ministry of Interior;
- Regulation for creating and organizing the activities of voluntary units to prevent or handle disasters, fires and emergencies and their consequences (adopted by Decree № 123 / 25.06.2012);
- Regulation for establishing, maintaining and keeping a register of voluntary units (reg. № Iz-1669 / 17.08.2012);
- Ordinance laying down procedures for obtaining of remuneration of volunteers for training and tasks for Disaster Protection (adopted by Decree № 143 / 20.06.2008);
- Annually by a decision of The Council of Ministers are adopted standards for State delegated activities.

RESPONIBLE INSTITUTIONS:

Authorities, which are involved in disaster response are organized into a "United rescue system" – URS

- Main components are: Fire fighters, Police, Emergency medical assisstance
- In different cases other components are: Army, Regional and local authorithies, Redcross, Voluntery units, Companies, NGOs etc.

MAIN COMPONENTS OF THE URS



EARLY WARNING SYSTEM

- Designed for individual warning and alert. It operates through a database, including predefined groups for disclosure.
- System capacity is up to 28,000 officials
- The system requires confirmation from the person by entering a personal identification number (PIN) for registration of disclosure.

HIERARCHY OF INSTITUTIONS THAT TAKE RESPONSIBILITY DURING DISASTERS:

MINISTRY OF INTERIOR – CHIEF DIRECTORATE "FIRE SAFETY AND CIVIL PROTECTION

At the national level are:

- 1. The President, the Speaker of Parliament, Prime Minister, Ministers;
- 2. The national headquarters for disaster protection and expert groups;
- 3. Ministries, state and executive agencies and commissions
 On the regional level are:
- 1. Regional Administration;
- 2. The headquarters for the implementation of the regional plan;
- 3. The municipal administration;
- 4. The headquarters for the implementation of municipal plan;
- 5. City Hall;

LEGAL FRAMEWORK

Law on Disaster Protection

- -Voluntary units are established by the Mayor
- Volunteer can be any able-bodied person over 18 who is clinically healthy and has not been convicted
- Person under 16 years and over 18, can be trained to volunteer without taking part in real activities

Law on The Ministry of Interior:

- -The Law specifies the powers of the volunteers as professional firefighters;
- -The authorities for Fire Safety and Civil Protection are assigned to provide methodological and expert assistance to mayors of municipalities in the establishment of voluntary units;
- The authorities for Fire Safety and Civil Protection are given the right to attract volunteers if necessary.



TRAININGS



- 1. Initial basic course;
- 2. Specialized training;
- 3. Support training;
- 4. Training for leaders of voluntary units;
- 5. Training of trainers of volunteers.
- 6. Ongoing training.



Initial basic course (3 modules)
Module I – 1915 volunteers
Module II – 1748 volunteers
Module III – 1139 volunteers

Ordinance laying down procedures for obtaining of remuneration of volunteers for training and tasks for Disaster Protection (adopted by Decree № 143 / 20.06.2008)

- Ar. 7. (1) Amount of remuneration of volunteers:
- 1. 100% of the minimum hourly wage for the country **for training lasting up to 10 days per year** (in proportion to the hours of participation in training)
- 2. 200% of the minimum hourly wage for the country for the execution of rescue activities **up to 20 days per year** (in proportion to the working hours of participation in rescue activities)

"Strategy for development of voluntary units for protection in case of disasters, fires and other emergencies on the territory of the Republic of Bulgaria 2012 - 2020 "

- Establishment of political framework for development of comprehensive and sustainable legal and institutional basis for successful state policy in the field of fire safety and protection of the population in case of disasters and other emergencies and for involvement of the civil society and local authorities in its implementation;
- Establishment of effective voluntary units within the territory of the Republic of Bulgaria for ensuring acceptable level of protection of the population and achieving average European level of first response in case of emergency.



Expected outcomes from implementation of the Strategy are as follows:



- Achieving average European level of availability of firefighters and rescuers for ensuring acceptable level of civil safety;
- Adequate legal basis regulating activity of the voluntary units;
- Establishment of efficient tools and mechanisms for encouragement of the population to participate in voluntary units;
- Enhancing volunteers' qualification;
- Raising awareness and participation of individuals and private sector in activities for ensuring their own safety and support the voluntary activities.

2015

✓ Construction of 15 self contained Voluntary Units;

2016

- ✓ Construction of effective Voluntary Units;
- ✓ Participation in courses under the Mechanism for Civil Protection of the EU and the Volunteer Corpus of the EU.

2017-2020

- ✓ Participation and implementation of European projects and programs to ensure the activities of Voluntary Units;
- ✓ Formation of a module of volunteers to be included in the Civil Protection Mechanism of the EU;
- ✓ Preparedness for participation in international rescue operations.


